

ఈ భవన నిర్మాణమునకు 111 లక్షలు ఖర్చు అయ్యననియు, 18 నెలలు పట్టెననియు కెలియుచున్నది. మొదటిలో చేయబడిన అంచనాకన్నను 21 లక్ష తక్కువ ఫిరీదులోను, తక్కువ న్యవధిగాను యా నిర్మాణము పూర్తి గావింపబడినదట. ఆడు లక్షల మాపాయల వరికరములుకూడా సేకరింపబడినవని కెలియుచున్నది.

ఈ కాలేజీలో క్రస్తుతము 4½ సంవత్సరముల కోర్సు గఱపబడు చుగ్నది. 170 మంది విద్యాస్థులు, 21 విద్యాస్థినులు గలరు.




May 2019 Group of classmates met in GMC to explore various options of renovation. We considered constructing a floor above the FORENSIC LAB for examination purposes.
